- Effective public health services depend on sustained and flexible funding that can be used to respond to community needs.
- IPHA will continue to monitor the merger between IDPH and IDHS and encourage a focus on community health strategies that benefit ALL Iowans.

# Cross-sector actions that address the root causes of health inequities

- Our greatest health challenges and solutions are highly complex and extend beyond the healthcare system.
- Improving the health of Iowans requires collaboration across health, economic, education, criminal justice, transportation, and other sectors.

# lowa's strong tradition of immunization as part of a healthy lifestyle

- IPHA supports increasing immunizations to protect individual and community health and opposes legislation that may decrease lowa's immunization rates.
- Support the mission of the IPHA-sponsored Iowa Immunizes Coalition to reduce and ultimately eliminate the incidence of vaccine preventable diseases.

#### Efforts to address lowa's mental health crisis
