

This week, the House passed several bills through floor debate, including legislation allowing for the sale of raw milk and cutting SNAP/Medicaid benefits. The raw milk bill included a six-page amendment, so must be reconsidered by the House, while the SNAP bill was the version initially sent over by the Senate, so it will head to the Governor's desk.

Additionally, the Senate began the confirmation process, passing all of the Governor's appointments through committee. They did not consider any bills on the Senate floor, and it is unclear if they will come back next week to do so.

As we inch closer to adjournment, the Senate and House are working through agreements on final budgets. The Senate has passed budget bills through committee without any appropriations, while the House has yet to introduce bills.
